The North Carolina Division on Career Development and Transition (NCDCDT) is proud to announce the sponsorship of the NCDCDT Lighthouse Award to recognize outstanding service in the field of Transition. This award will be given to an individual or group that has made a difference through commitment and dedication to ensuring that all students with disabilities in North Carolina make a successful transition from school to adult life. Nominees for the award may be Adult Service Providers, Business Leaders, Central Services Personnel, Civic Groups, Parents, Post-Secondary Educators, Principals, Teachers, or Transition Coordinators.

Any interested individual may submit one or more nominations. Nominations will be accepted by the NCDCDT through **MARCH 01, 2018**. Nominations will be reviewed and judged by the Executive Board of the NCDCDT. The individual making the nomination will be notified by **March 15, 2018** if their nominee is the recipient of the award. The winner will be announced during the **2018 NCDCDT Transition Conference**. The winner and the individual nominating him/her/them will be invited to the NCDCDT Transition Conference, **April 18 - 20, 2018**, for a special ceremony honoring all award recipients. The **2018** conference registration fee for the winner will be waived.

The NCDCDT Lighthouse Award nominations must be emailed to the designated address by MARCH 01, 2018. Please email the completed nomination form and any supporting documentation. Nominations submitted after MARCH 01, 2018 will be declared ineligible.
